32 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 33 34 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 35 Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005 36 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 37 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 38 39 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 40 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 41 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 42 act. 43 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 44 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal 45 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 46 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 47 48 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services" 49 50 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 51 52 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 53 54 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with

55 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or

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allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

67 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 68 Pearl River Basin Development District shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 69 70 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 71 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 72 Year 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 73 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be 74 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 75 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 76 provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process.

77 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 78 Director of the Pearl River Basin Development District shall be authorized to escalate, budget and expend funds from any source, 79 80 not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00), for the purpose of maintaining the Lower Pearl Restoration Project in 81 82 accordance with the Project Cooperation Agreement with the United States Army Corps of Engineers and to maintain the South Jackson 83 Clearing Project in an area along the Pearl River in Hinds County 84 and Rankin County, in accordance with rules and regulations of the 85 86 Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent 87 with the escalation of federal funds.

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88 SECTION 5. The funds herein approved for expenditure, except 89 and less an amount approved by the State Fiscal Officer which 90 shall be sufficient to cover disbursements for current operations, 91 shall be deposited at interest with any official depository of the 92 state at a rate of interest numerically not less than one percent 93 (1%) below the bank discount rate on United States Treasury bills 94 of comparable maturity as determined by the State Treasurer.

95 SECTION 6. The money herein approved for expenditure shall 96 be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer 97 or officers, in the manner provided by law or in accordance with 98 the provisions of a valid trust indenture.

99 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 100 and after July 1, 2004.
