COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO**

House Bill No. 1709

**Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting
in lieu thereof the following:**

6 **SECTION 1.** The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
7 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
8 Treasury to the credit of the State Board of Registration for
9 Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors, for the purpose of
10 defraying the expenses of the board for the fiscal year beginning
11 July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005..... \$ 422,477.00.

12 **SECTION 2.** Of the funds approved for expenditure under the
13 provisions of Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below
14 shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
15 expenditure:

16 **MAJOR OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURE:**

17 Personal Services:

18 Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits.. \$ 212,637.00
19 Travel and Subsistence..... 26,000.00
20 Contractual Services..... 164,040.00
21 Commodities..... 16,300.00

22 Capital Outlay:

23 Other Than Equipment..... 0.00
24 Equipment..... 3,500.00

57 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
58 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
59 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
60 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
61 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
62 appropriated level.

63 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
64 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
65 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
66 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

67 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
68 State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land
69 Surveyors shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records
70 related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this
71 act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of
72 detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2004. It is further the
73 intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for
74 Fiscal Year 2006 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative
75 Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the
76 format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2005
77 budget request process.

78 **SECTION 4.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
79 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
80 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
81 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
82 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
83 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

84 **SECTION 5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
85 and after July 1, 2004.
