31	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of			
32	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to			
33	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal			
34	Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005			
35	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions			
36	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the			
37	Mississippi Legisla	ture. Based on data provided	by the	
38	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall			
39	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all			
40	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this			
41	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure			
42	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual			
43	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal			
44	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.			
45	If, at the time the	agency takes any action to c	hange "Personal	
46	Services," the Stat	e Personnel Board determines	that the agency	
47	has taken an action	which would cause the agency	to exceed this	
48	projected annual co	st or the Fiscal Year 2005 "P	ersonal Services"	
49	appropriated level,	when annualized, then only t	hose actions which

- 58 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 59 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 60 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 61 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 63 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 64 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 65 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 66 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 67 State Oil and Gas Board shall maintain complete accounting and
- 68 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 69 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- 70 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
- 71 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
- 72 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be submitted to
- 73 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 74 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 75 during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process.
- 76 **SECTION 4.** With the funds provided herein, it is the
- 77 intention of the Legislature that the State Oil and Gas Board
- 78 purchase liability insurance.
- 79 **SECTION 5.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 80 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 81 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 82 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 83 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 84 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 85 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 86 and after July 1, 2004.
