With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 58 59 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 60 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 61 Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005 62 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 63 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the 64 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 65 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 66 67 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 68 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. 69 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 70 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal 71 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 72 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 73 74 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 75 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services" 76 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 77 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 78 79 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

80 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 81 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 82 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 83 84 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 85 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 86 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 87 88 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

93 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Governor's Office - Division of Medicaid shall maintain complete 94 95 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 96 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 97 Year 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 98 99 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be 100 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 101 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 102 provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process.

SECTION 6. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted performance measures provided below:

SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Executive Director of the Division of Medicaid may authorize increases in any major objects of expenditures in total amounts not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the appropriated amount of each major object of expenditure, provided that other major objects of expenditure are decreased by a corresponding dollar amount.

SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 129 130 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 131 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 132 133 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 134 SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from 135 and after July 1, 2004. 136
