With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 30 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 31 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 32 33 Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005 34 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 35 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the 36 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 37 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 38 39 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 40 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 41 42 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 43 44 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 45 46 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 47 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 48 49 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 50 51 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

52 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 53 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 54 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State

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55 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 56 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 57 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 58 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 59 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 60 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

65 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the State Fire Academy shall maintain complete accounting and 66 67 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 68 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 69 70 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be submitted to 71 72 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 73 during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process. 74

SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 75 76 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 77 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 78 79 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 80 81 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2004. 82

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
