AMENDMENT NO 1 TO COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED  
TO**

**House Bill No. 1832**

1           **AMEND by striking Section 7 and inserting in lieu thereof the**  
2 **following:**

3           **SECTION 7.** Before the tax authorized by this act may be  
4 imposed, the governing authorities must adopt a resolution  
5 declaring their intention to levy the tax, setting forth the  
6 amount of such tax and establishing the date on which this tax  
7 initially shall be levied and collected. Notice of the tax shall  
8 be published once each week for at least three (3) consecutive  
9 weeks in a newspaper having a general circulation in the City of  
10 Jackson, the first publication of which shall be made not less  
11 than twenty-one (21) days before the date on which the tax  
12 initially is to be levied and collected. If, within the time of  
13 giving notice, twenty percent (20%) of the qualified electors of  
14 the City of Jackson file a written petition against the levy of  
15 the tax, then the tax shall not be levied unless authorized by a  
16 majority of the qualified electors of the City of Jackson voting  
17 at an election to be called and held for that purpose. At least  
18 thirty (30) days before the effective date of the tax, the  
19 governing authorities shall furnish to the State Tax Commission a  
20 certified copy of the resolution evidencing such tax.

21           **FURTHER, amend the title to conform.**
