AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO**

Senate Bill No. 2514

1 **AMEND by inserting after line 13 the following:**

2 **SECTION *.** (1) It is unlawful for a person to shine a light
3 exceeding 250,000 candle power from a public road onto the
4 adjoining lands of another during the night from one-half (1/2)
5 hour after sunset to one-half (1/2) hour before sunrise. This
6 section does not apply to the normal use of headlights of a
7 vehicle traveling on a public road, to law enforcement, emergency
8 or utility personnel in the performance of their duty, to a lessee
9 on lands leased by the lessee or to a person having the permission
10 of the landowner.

11 (2) A first offense under this section shall receive a
12 warning citation which shall be of public record. Any person
13 convicted of a second or subsequent violation of this section
14 shall be punished by a fine of not less than One Hundred Dollars
15 (\$100.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or by
16 imprisonment in the county jail for not less than sixty (60) days
17 nor more than six (6) months, or by both such fine and
18 imprisonment.

19 **FURTHER amend title in line 6 by inserting after the**
20 **semicolon thereon the following:**

21 TO PROHIBIT THE SHINING OF A HIGH-INTENSITY LIGHT FROM A PUBLIC
22 ROAD ONTO THE ADJOINING LANDS OF ANOTHER DURING THE NIGHT, TO
23 PROVIDE EXCEPTIONS, AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS;
