- 3 (1) There is created a task force to study SECTION *. voting systems that comply with the Help America Vote Act of 2002 4 5 and their suitability for use in elections in Mississippi. 6 task force shall make a report of its findings and recommendations to the Legislature during the 2005 Regular Session, including any 7 recommended legislation. 8 9 (2) The task force shall be composed of the following 10 members: The Secretary of State, or his designee; 11 (a) The Chairman of the Elections Committee of the

- 14 (C) The Chairman of the Apportionment and Elections
- Committee of the House of Representatives; 15
- A circuit clerk appointed by the President of the 16
- Mississippi Association of Circuit Clerks; 17
- A member of the general public who is not an 18
- 19 elected official or state employee, appointed by the Governor;
- 20 (f) A member of the general public who is not an
- 21 elected official or state employee, appointed by the Lieutenant
- 22 Governor; and

- 23 (g) A member of the general public who is not an 24 elected official or state employee, appointed by the Speaker of
- 25 the House of Representatives.
- 26 (3) Appointments shall be made within thirty (30) days after
- 27 the effective date of this act, and, within fifteen (15) days
- 28 thereafter on a day to be designated jointly by the Speaker of the
- 29 House and the Lieutenant Governor, the task force shall meet and
- 30 organize by selecting from its membership a chairman and a vice
- 31 chairman. The vice chairman shall also serve as secretary and
- 32 shall be responsible for keeping all records of the task force. A
- 33 majority of the members of the task force shall constitute a
- 34 quorum. In the selection of its officers and the adoption of
- 35 rules, resolutions and reports, an affirmative vote of a majority
- 36 of the task force shall be required. All members shall be
- 37 notified in writing of all meetings, such notices to be mailed at
- 38 least fifteen (15) days before the date on which a meeting is to
- 39 be held.
- 40 (4) The task force shall study voting systems that comply
- 41 with the Help America Vote Act of 2002 and make recommendations
- 42 regarding the types of voting systems that are suitable for use in
- 43 Mississippi.
- 44 (5) Members of the task force who are not legislators, state
- 45 officials or state employees shall be compensated at the per diem
- 46 rate authorized by Section 25-3-69 and shall be reimbursed in
- 47 accordance with Section 25-3-41 for mileage and actual expenses
- 48 incurred in the performance of their duties. Legislative members
- 49 of the task force shall be paid from the contingent expense funds
- 50 of their respective houses in the same manner as provided for
- 51 committee meetings when the Legislature is not in session.
- 52 However, no per diem or expense for attending meetings of the task
- 53 force will be paid to legislative members of the task force while
- 54 the Legislature is in session. No task force member may incur per

- 55 diem, travel or other expenses unless previously authorized by
- 56 vote, at a meeting of the task force, which action shall be
- 57 recorded in the official minutes of the meeting. Nonlegislative
- 58 members shall be paid from any funds made available to the task
- 59 force for that purpose.
- 60 (6) The task force shall use clerical and legal staff
- 61 already employed by the Legislature and any other staff assistance
- 62 made available to it. To effectuate the purposes of this section,
- 63 any department, division, board, bureau, commission or agency of
- 64 the state or of any political subdivision thereof shall, at the
- 65 request of the chairman of the task force, provide to the task
- 66 force such facilities, assistance and data as will enable the task
- 67 force to properly carry out its task.
- 68 (7) Upon presentation of its report to the Legislature at
- 69 the 2005 Regular Session, the task force shall be dissolved.
- 70 FURTHER, AMEND line 60 of the title by inserting the 71 following after the semicolon:
