HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 2

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING MISS MELISSA LINDSAY
2 "MISSY" MAY ON BEING SELECTED AS MADISON COUNTY'S MISS HOSPITALITY
3 2004 AND FOR HER MANY DISTINGUISHED ACCOMPLISHMENTS.

4 WHEREAS, Miss Melissa Lindsay "Missy" May, daughter of Rusty
5 and Cheryl May of Madison, Mississippi, was selected by Mayor
6 Hawkins Butler of Madison and the Madison Board of Alderman as
7 Madison County's Miss Hospitality 2004 to serve as the county's
8 representative in the state competition and goodwill ambassador in
9 the areas of tourism and economic development; and

10 WHEREAS, a fifteen-year resident of Madison, Mississippi,
11 Miss May is a 2002 graduate of Madison-Ridgeland Academy (MRA),

20 College, Miss May continues to maintain her active involvement in
21 volunteerism and service through participation in NT Social Tribe,
22 SGA House of Representatives, Mississippi College "Naturals,"

24 and BSU in addition to serving as sophomore homecoming maid; and

25 WHEREAS, Miss May, a member of the Church of the Highlands,
26 began her volunteer services when she was six year of age, which
27 have continually expanded throughout her life as she has served on

28 the Partnership for a Healthy Mississippi Rat Pak, "Mississippi
