- 15 automobile is the greatest invention of his lifetime, a mechanism
- 16 that made the world smaller; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Mr. King married Lavenia Napier on December 27,

- 20 WHEREAS, from 1933 to 1945, Mr. King gained the title "the
- 21 ice man" by delivering ice to the rural areas around Bassfield and
- 22 Sumrall; and
- 23 WHEREAS, after World War II, Mr. King ended his career as
- 24 "the ice man," and began carpentry work along with his farming to
- 25 provide for his family; and
- 26 WHEREAS, blessed with three children, Mr. King has enjoyed
