1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE PEARL RIVER
2 COMMUNITY COLLEGE MEN'S SOCCER TEAM UPON ITS OUTSTANDING 2003-2004
3 SEASON AND WINNING THE MISSISSIPPI ASSOCIATION OF COMMUNITY AND
4 JUNIOR COLLEGE'S (MACJC) STATE CHAMPIONSHIP.
