Richard was born in 1795 and died in 1875; his 20 son, John M. King, was born in 1836 and died in 1905; his son, 21 Abner N. King, was born in 1868 and died in 1917; and

22 WHEREAS, this family icon has witnessed many historic events 23 during his lifetime, including the invention of the automobile by 24 Henry Ford, the Wright Brothers' first airplane flight and man's 25 walk on the moon; and
