A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE LIFE OF RETIRED U.S. ARMY MAJOR 1 GENERAL GENE PERRY HALE OF VICKSBURG, MISSISSIPPI, AND EXPRESSING 2 3 THE SYMPATHY OF THE SENATE. 4 WHEREAS, retired U.S. Army Major General Gene Perry Hale died Saturday, May 15, 2004, in Vicksburg, Mississippi; and 5 WHEREAS, General Hale was a Vicksburg native and a 1956 6 7 graduate of St. Aloysius High School. He received his Civil 8 Engineering Degree from the University of Mississippi; and 9 WHEREAS, he was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in the Mississippi Army National Guard in 1959. After completing the 10 Engineer Officers' Basic Course in Fort Belvoir, Virginia, he 11 12 returned to the MSARNG and served as platoon leader, construction 13 engineer and Company Commander for Company B of the 114th Engineer Battalion, and as Company Commander for the 157th Engineer 14 15 Company, 273rd Engineer Battalion. His later assignments included Motor Officer, 273rd Engineer Battalion, and Assistant Engineer 16 Officer, Engineer Officer and Assistant S3 of the 168th Engineer 17 18 Group; and

WHEREAS, in U.S. Army Reserve status he served as Military 19 20 Intelligence Officer, 475th Military Intelligence Detachment, and 21 as Construction Engineer, Military Intelligence Staff Officer, 22 Topographic Staff Officer, Assistant Chief of Staff, Personnel, Chief of Staff and Deputy Commander of the 412th Engineer Command. 23 He was appointed Commander of the 412th Engineer Command in May 24 1991 and promoted to Major General in November 1991; and 25 26 WHEREAS, General Hale worked at the U.S. Army Engineers 27 Waterways Experiment Station in Vicksburg as Supervisory Civil

Engineer-Chief of the Soils Research Center in the Soil and Rock Mechanics Division of the Geotechnical Laboratory. He retired in 1994 after nearly 35 years and received the Distinguished Service Medal, one of the highest medals awarded during peacetime; and WHEREAS, General Hale was a member of St. Paul Catholic Church and the Port City Kiwanis Club; and
