- 6 WHEREAS, Ms. Doiron has received the singular honor of being

Nurse Practitioner with offices in Vicksburg, Mississippi; and

- 7 the first Nurse Practitioner in the nation to receive a
- 8 prestigious primary award entitled the "2004 Clinician of the Year
- 9 Award" which is given by the American Academy of Home Care
- 10 Physicians, a national association for physicians and nurse
- 11 practitioners; and

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- 12 WHEREAS, this group is a national association for physicians
- 13 and nurse practitioners who formally perform "old-fashioned house
- 14 calls" for those patients who are unable to travel without extreme
- 15 hardship. In a nutshell, house calls are performed on those
- 16 patients who are most needy, frail and homebound; and
- 17 WHEREAS, in collaboration with the physician, the specific
- 18 role as a house call nurse practitioner is to perform:
- Complete medical examinations for chronic and acute medical
- 20 problems.
- Establish medical plans of care, including treatments,
- 22 referrals and consults.
- Review polypharmacy issues.
- Safety monitoring (i.e., abuse screening, physical
- environment assessments).
- Monitor and gather data for health screening and promotion.
- Incorporate patient education into the medical plan of care.

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- 28 • Provide case management with other "team" members, including 29 home health agencies, hospice services, pharmacists, DME 30 companies and therapists; and WHEREAS, with the guidance of the Academy, Whitney was able 31 32 to work closely with the Mississippi Board of Nursing to establish 33 a procedure and model of operation that would benefit the 34 patients, service the physicians, and meet the state and federal requirements for nurse practitioners. The experience has been 35 overwhelmingly exciting for Whitney, who states how wonderful it 36 is to go into a patient's home, sit down and just listen to them 37 38 and their family. The patients are the true winners.
