## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 504

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING JUDY RHODES OF THE 1 MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR 33 YEARS OF FAITHFUL 2 SERVICE TO PUBLIC EDUCATION AND THE BOYS AND GIRLS OF MISSISSIPPI UPON THE OCCASION OF HER RETIREMENT FROM THE DEPARTMENT. 3 4 WHEREAS, Judy Rhodes has 33 years of service in education, 5 6 with 20 of those years served at the Mississippi Department of 7 Education, where she most recently served as Director of the Office of Educational Accountability, providing annual 8 9 accountability reports to the Legislature, the Governor and the 10 people of Mississippi concerning the status of education in 11 Mississippi; and

12 WHEREAS, her legislative duties included reporting all state 13 and local financial and performance aspects of elementary and 14 secondary education, and coordinating with the Attorney General's 15 Office on legal issues affecting the department and local school 16 districts; and

17 WHEREAS, Judy Rhodes also provided oversight and management of the Office of the Budget, which develops and manages the annual 18 19 education budget; the Offices of Internal Audit and Program Monitoring, which provide internal audit services to the State 20 21 Board of Education and State Superintendent of Education, resolve findings of annual school district audits, and provide annual 22 23 evaluation and monitoring assessments of department functions; and 24 the Office of Financial Accountability, which provides financial and technical assistance to school districts and administers the 25 26 state's primary funding for school districts, including the Minimum Foundation Program, Equity Funding, the Mississippi 27

28 Adequate Education Program and the Public Employees' Health 29 Insurance Program; and

30 WHEREAS, she previously served as Executive Director of the 31 Office of Job Development and Training, which included 32 responsibility for a federal employment and training program 33 service for at-risk youth, teen parents, displaced homemakers, 34 dislocated workers and economically disadvantaged Mississippians; 35 Chairman of the Board of the Mississippi Broadcasting Network and 36 served as a mathematics teacher; and
