When the results of the election shall have been canvassed and certified, the (city) county may levy the tax if 21 22 sixty percent (60%) of the qualified electors who vote in the election vote in favor of the tax. At least thirty (30) days 23 before the effective date of the tax provided in this section, the 24 (governing authorities to board of supervisors shall furnish to the 25 State Tax Commission a certified copy of the resolution evidencing 26 27 the tax.
