HOUSE BILL NO. 31

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-61-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO  
2 DELETE CERTAIN PROVISIONS UNDER THE MISSISSIPPI PUBLIC RECORDS ACT  
3 OF 1983 THAT AUTHORIZE A PUBLIC BODY TO ESTABLISH AND COLLECT FEES  
4 FOR SEARCHING AND REVIEWING PUBLIC RECORDS; AND FOR RELATED  
5 PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

7 **SECTION 1.** Section 25-61-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is  
8 amended as follows:

9 25-61-7. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this  
10 section, each public body may establish and collect fees  
11 reasonably calculated to reimburse it for, and in no case to  
12 exceed, the actual cost of \* \* \* duplicating and, if applicable,  
13 mailing copies of public records. Such fees shall be collected by  
14 the public body in advance of complying with the request.

15 (2) A public body may establish a standard fee scale to  
16 reimburse it for the costs of creating, acquiring and maintaining  
17 a geographic information system or multipurpose cadastre as  
18 authorized and defined under Section 25-61-1 et seq., or any other  
19 electronically accessible data. Such fees must be reasonably  
20 related to the cost of creating, acquiring and maintaining the  
21 geographic information system, multipurpose cadastre or other  
22 electronically accessible data, for the data or information  
23 contained therein or taken therefrom and for any records, papers,  
24 accounts, maps, photographs, films, cards, tapes, recordings or  
25 other materials, data or information relating thereto, whether in  
26 printed, digital or other format. In determining the fees or  
27 charges under this subsection, the public body may consider the  
28 type of information requested, the purpose or purposes for which

29 the information has been requested and the commercial value of the  
30 information.

31         **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
32 and after July 1, 2005.
