(1) Any owner of a motor vehicle, who is a

40 resident of this state, upon complying with the motor vehicle laws 41 relating to registration and licensing of motor vehicles, and upon 42 payment of the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes 43 and registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of 44 passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles,

and upon payment of an additional annual fee in the amount 45 46 provided in subsection (3) of this section, shall be issued a 47 special license tag for each motor vehicle registered in his name 48 identifying such person as a supporter of the Homebuilders 49 Association of Mississippi. The distinctive license tags so 50 issued shall be of such color and design as the State Tax Commission, with the advice of the Chief Executive Officer of the 51 Homebuilders Association of Mississippi, may prescribe, and shall 52 consist of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary 53 54 to distinguish each license tag.

55 Application for the distinctive license tags authorized (2) by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms 56 57 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less 58 59 Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector, 60 shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis 61 as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional 62 fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the 63 county general fund.

64 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or 65 after July 1, 2005, any person applying for a distinctive license 66 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag 67 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all 68 69 other taxes and fees.
