- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 99-17-9, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 99-17-9. In criminal cases the presence of the prisoner may
- 8 be waived, and the trial progress, at the discretion of the court,
- 9 in his absence, if he be in custody and consenting thereto. If
- 10 the defendant \* \* \* be on recognizance or bail or has been
- 11 arrested and escaped, or has been notified by the proper officer
- 12 of the pendency of the indictment against him, and resisted or
- 13 fled, or refused to be taken, or be in any way in default for
- 14 nonappearance, the trial may progress at the discretion of the
- 15 court, and judgment final and sentence be awarded as though such
- 16 defendant were personally present in court.
- 17 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 18 and after July 1, 2005
