HOUSE BILL NO. 218

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-41, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 EXTEND THE REPEALER ON BAG LIMITS FOR GAME ANIMALS, BIRDS AND 3 FISH; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 49-7-41, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
reenacted and amended as follows:

7 49-7-41. (1) The commission may set the bag limits for game
8 animals, birds and fish, unless the bag limits are established by
9 the Legislature by statute.

10 (2) (a) The bag limit on antlered deer is one (1) per day, 11 not to exceed three (3) per license year. An antlered deer must 12 have antlers of four (4) points or greater to be taken except as 13 provided in paragraph (b) of this subsection.

(b) An antlered deer with less than four (4) points may 14 15 be taken by permit if it is necessary to manage deer on lands 16 under the deer management assistance program or wildlife management areas. A written management justification issued by 17 18 the Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks must accompany any request for such a permit. Any antlered deer with less than four 19 20 (4) points harvested under this permit must be identified with a 21 tag immediately upon possession. Antlered deer taken by permit shall be subject to the daily bag limit but shall not be subject 22 to the annual bag limit on antlered deer. The department shall 23 include a report on permits issued, to whom issued and deer 24 harvested in the department's annual deer program report. 25

26 (3) (a) The bag limit on antlerless deer is one (1)
27 per day, not to exceed three (3) per license year; except that two

(2) additional antlerless deer per license year may be taken with
a bow and arrow. Antlerless deer may be taken only in the areas
prescribed by order of the commission. It is illegal to take a
spotted fawn in any season.

32 (b) It is unlawful for a nonresident to kill an 33 antlerless deer except: (i) a nonresident may take antlerless deer on lands that the title is vested in the nonresident or on 34 35 lands that the nonresident has leased the hunting and fishing rights; or (ii) a nonresident who has a native son or daughter 36 nonresident lifetime sportsman license or a resident lifetime 37 38 sportsman license may take antlerless deer on private lands, wildlife management areas or national wildlife refuges. 39

40 (4) The bag limit on antlerless deer set by this section
41 shall not apply to private lands under the deer management
42 assistance program or the fee-based antlerless program as approved
43 by the department.

44 (5) This section shall stand repealed on July 1, <u>2007</u>.
45 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
46 and after July 1, 2005.
