- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 57-30-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 reenacted and amended as follows:
- 7 57-30-5. (1) The MDA shall develop, implement and
- 8 administer the incentive program authorized in this chapter and
- 9 shall promulgate rules and regulations necessary for the
- 10 development, implementation and administration of such program.
- 11 (2) A person, corporation or other entity desiring to
- 12 participate in the incentive payment program authorized in this
- 13 chapter must submit an application to the MDA. Such application
- 14 must contain (a) plans for the proposed project; (b) a detailed
- 15 description of the proposed project; (c) the method of financing
- 16 the proposed project and the terms of such financing; and (d) any
- 17 other information required by the MDA. The Executive Director of
- 18 the MDA shall review the application and determine whether it
- 19 qualifies as a project. If the executive director determines the
- 20 proposed project qualifies as a project, he shall issue a
- 21 certificate to the person, corporation or other entity designating
- 22 such person, corporation or other entity as an approved
- 23 participant and authorizing the approved participant to
- 24 participate in the incentive payment program provided for in this
- 25 chapter; however, no certificates shall be issued after July 1,
- 26 2004, for projects that pertain to facilities whose primary
- 27 purpose is the retail sale of tangible personal property.

- 28 (3) This section shall stand repealed from and after July 1,
- 29 <u>2007</u>.
- 30 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 31 and after July 1, 2005.
