- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4
- SECTION 1. Section 49-1-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 49-1-13. The director is hereby authorized and directed to
- 8 appoint as many conservation officers as may be required to
- efficiently enforce the laws for the protection of wild animals, 9
- birds and fish, and the laws relating to theft of cattle, trespass 10
- prohibitions and litter. These officers shall be located in 11
- different sections of the state where their services are most 12
- 13 needed. Conservation officers shall police the state lands in
- their respective districts and prohibit the unlawful cutting of 14
- 15 timber. The salary of the conservation officers shall be as
- determined by the State Personnel Board, or its successor. 16
- However, beginning July 1, 2005, the amount of the annual salary 17
- 18 of the conservation officers shall be increased by One Thousand
- Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) over the amount that the officers 19
- were receiving on June 30, 2005. 20
