HOUSE BILL NO. 597

- AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT ANY STUDENT IN GRADES SEVEN THROUGH
 TWELVE ENROLLED IN A PUBLIC SCHOOL IN MISSISSIPPI SHALL NOT
 PARTICIPATE IN ANY ATHLETIC PROGRAM UNLESS THAT STUDENT MAINTAINS
 A 2.0 GRADE POINT AVERAGE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Beginning with the 2005-2006 school year, any
- 7 student in Grades 7 through 12 enrolled in a public school of this
- 8 state shall not participate in any athletic program unless that
- 9 student maintains a 2.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.
- 10 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 11 and after July 1, 2005.
