## HOUSE BILL NO. 610

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 17-25-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, WHICH AUTHORIZES THE GOVERNING BODY OF ANY COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY TO SELL, LEASE OR CONVEY CERTAIN PROPERTY BELONGING TO THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY TO ANY NONPROFIT PRIMARY HEALTH CARE CLINIC WITH A SECTION 501(C)(3) STATUS, TO REMOVE THE REPEAL DATE OF JULY 1, 2005, FROM THIS PROVISION OF LAW; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: **SECTION 1.** Section 17-25-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:

10 17-25-3. (1) The governing body of any county or municipality, in its discretion, may sell, lease or convey, with 11 or without consideration and upon such terms and conditions as the 12 parties may agree, any land, buildings, fixtures, equipment or 13 other real or personal property belonging to the county or 14 municipality that is determined by the governing body as no longer 15 needed by the county or municipality for governmental purposes, to 16 17 any nonprofit primary health care clinic, which is exempt from federal income taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal 18 Revenue Code located or to be located in the county for the 19 20 purpose of assisting any such clinic to provide primary health 21 care services to residents who are employed or temporarily out of 22 work and who do not have health insurance. If such property is sold, leased or conveyed without consideration, the governing body 23 24 of the county or municipality shall state in its minutes the purpose for which the property shall be used, and such property 25 shall revert to the county or municipality whenever it ceases to 26 27 be used for that stated purpose.
