HOUSE BILL NO. 667

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-27-9, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 REVISE THE TYPES OF FEES CHARGED BY THE COMMISSION ON MARINE 2 3 RESOURCES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. Section 49-27-9, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5 6 amended as follows: 7 49-27-9. (1) No * * * coastal wetlands shall be altered without a permit unless excluded in Section 49-27-7. Any person 8 proposing to alter, directly or indirectly, any coastal wetlands 9 or adjacent waters shall file an application for a permit with the 10 commission in such form and with such information as the 11 commission may prescribe. Applicants shall submit one (1) of the 12 13 following fees: (a) Private, single family construction project for 14 15 recreational access or shoreline alterations with a combined 16 impact/shaded area not exceeding fifteen hundred (1500) square feet.....\$ 50.00; 17 (b) Private, single family construction project with a 18 combined impact/shaded area exceeding fifteen hundred (1500) 19 20 square feet.....\$ 300.00; 21 (c) Projects associated with a commercial or industrial 22 operation with a combined impact/shaded area not exceeding fifteen 23 hundred (1500) square feet..... \$ 500.00; (d) Projects associated with a commercial or industrial 24 operation with a combined impact/shaded area exceeding fifteen 25 26 hundred (1500) square feet and not exceeding one (1) acre 27 <u>.....</u> \$1,000.00; *HR03/R1156*

28 (e) Projects associated with a commercial or industrial 29 operation with a combined impact/shaded area exceeding one (1) acre of impacts to state water bottoms, coastal wetlands or 30 31 adjacent wetlands, or any proposed off-shore petroleum exploration 32 or development, including costs of court reporter required for 33 public or evidentiary hearing specific to the project.. \$5,000.00. The appropriate fee shall be submitted along with the application 34 and made payable to the Department of Marine Resources. No permit 35 shall be required under this chapter of any individual who seeks 36 to construct, without impacts to coastal wetlands, a home, fishing 37 38 camp or similar structure on his own property. (2) If the commission determines that the activity, area or 39 40 entity is exempt or requires no permit, and that the activity, area or entity complies with the notification requirement and the 41 coastal wetland policy as required under Section 49-27-7, the 42 commission may reduce the application fee by fifty percent (50%). 43 (3) The commission shall waive the herein specified 44 application fee charges of any project of a federal, state or 45 local governmental entity. 46 47 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

48 and after July 1, 2005.
