COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 671

1 AN ACT TO REGULATE THE BAG LIMIT FOR CERTAIN SPECIES OF FISH; 2 TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE REGULATIONS; TO 3 DESCRIBE WHO SHALL BE JOINTLY AND SEVERALLY LIABLE FOR THE IMPOSED 4 PENALTIES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 6 SECTION 1. (1) It is unlawful for any recreational 7 fisherman to catch, take, possess or land below minimum legal size or over creel limit red snapper (Lutjanus campechanus), misty 8 9 grouper (Epinephelus mystacinus), snowy grouper (Epinephelus niveatus), yellowedge grouper (Epinephelus flavolimbatus), red 10 grouper (Epinephelus morio), black grouper (Mycteroperca bonaci), 11 gag grouper (Mycteroperca microlepis), scamp (Mycteroperca 12 phenax), yellowmouth (Mycteroperca interstitialis), rock hind 13 (Epinephalus adscensionis), and red hind (Epinephalus guttatus), 14 as established by regulations promulgated by the commission. 15

16 (2) Any recreational fisherman who violates the provisions 17 of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined in 18 the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) for one (1) fish 19 possessed in violation of this section or commission ordinance, 20 and fined Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for every fish over one 21 (1) possessed in violation of this section.

Any recreational fisherman who violates the provisions 22 (3) 23 of this section or commission ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor 24 and shall be fined in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) for one (1) fillet of any species, and fined Five 25 26 Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for every fillet over one (1) of any species, except as provided in Section 49-15-319. For purposes of 27 this chapter, fillet is defined as any piece or slice of fish. 28 *HR03/R1164CS* H. B. No. 671 G1/2 05/HR03/R1164CS PAGE 1 ($GT\LH$)

(4) The master and owner of any vessel upon which any fish 29 or fillet is possessed in violation of this section shall be 30 jointly and severally liable for the penalty imposed herein. 31 32 (5) The fine imposed upon any recreational fisherman or 33 other person convicted under this section shall not be suspended or reduced. This section applies only to recreational fishermen, 34 35 whether licensed or not, and does not apply to commercial fishermen. 36

37 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from38 and after July 1, 2005.
