HOUSE BILL NO. 735

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI HAS ADOPTED
2 THE FEDERAL REGULATIONS CONCERNING THE MAXIMUM DRIVING AND ON-DUTY
3 REQUIREMENTS OF TRANSPORTERS WITH AN EXCEPTION FOR INTRASTATE
4 TRANSPORTERS OF AGRICULTURAL COMMODITIES OR FARM SUPPLIES FOR
5 AGRICULTURAL PURPOSES WITHIN A CERTAIN RADIUS FROM THE SOURCE OF
6 THE COMMODITIES OR DISTRIBUTION POINT FOR THE FARM SUPPLIES; AND
7 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

9 **SECTION 1.** The State of Mississippi has adopted 49 CFR Part
10 395 as of January 1, 2005, with the following exception: The
11 maximum driving and on-duty requirements shall not apply to
12 intrastate transporters of agricultural commodities or farm
13 supplies for agricultural purposes if the transportation is
14 limited to an area within a one hundred-air-mile radius from the
15 source of the commodities or distribution point for the farm
16 supplies.

17 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
18 and after July 1, 2005.
