- **SECTION 1.** In all kindergarten through Grade 12 schools of 6
- 7 this state that have vending machines, only milk, water, one
- hundred percent (100%) natural juices, fresh or dried fruits and 8
- 9 vegetables and whole-grain snacks may be sold in those machines.
- 10 However, vending machines located in faculty or teachers' lounges
- or located where only adults have access to the machines, and 11
- vending machines operated only during athletic events, are exempt 12
- from the requirements of this section. 13
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 14
- and after July 1, 2005. However, if a school district is under an 15
- 16 existing contract with a company to provide vending services on
- 17 July 1, 2005, then the provisions of this act shall be applicable
- to the schools in that district after the date that the contract 18
- 19 expires.
