HOUSE BILL NO. 818

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 47-5-1211, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 2 TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS TO PAY CERTAIN COSTS 3 ASSOCIATED WITH THE ANNUAL INMATE COST PER DAY REVIEW THAT IS 4 CONDUCTED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE ON PERFORMANCE 5 EVALUATION AND EXPENDITURE REVIEW(PEER COMMITTEE); AND FOR RELATED 6 PURPOSES. 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 47-5-1211, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows: 9 10 47-5-1211. (1) A contract for private correctional facilities or services shall not be entered into unless the 11 contractor has demonstrated that it has: 12 13 The qualifications, experience and management (a) personnel necessary to carry out the terms of the contract. 14 The ability to expedite the siting, design and (b) 15 construction of correctional facilities. 16 (c) The ability to comply with applicable laws, court 17 orders and national correctional standards. 18 (d) Demonstrated history of successful operation and 19 20 management of other correctional facilities. (2) A facility shall at all times comply with all federal 21 22 and state laws, and all applicable court orders. (3) (a) No contract for private incarceration shall be 23 24 entered into unless the cost of the private operation, including 25 the state's cost for monitoring the private operation, offers a cost savings of at least ten percent (10%) to the Department of 26 27 Corrections for at least the same level and quality of service offered by the Department of Corrections. 28

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The Joint Legislative Committee on Performance 29 (b) Evaluation and Expenditure Review (PEER Committee) shall contract 30 annually with a certified public accounting firm to establish a 31 32 state inmate cost per day for a comparable state facility. The 33 Department of Corrections shall be responsible for paying the contractor selected by the PEER Committee. The state inmate cost 34 per day shall be certified annually. The certified cost shall be 35 used as the basis for measuring the validity of the ten percent 36 (10%) savings of the contractor costs. 37

(4) The rates and benefits for correctional services shall 38 39 be negotiated based upon American Correction Association standards, state law and court orders. 40

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 41 and after July 1, 2005. 42
