5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
6	SECTION 1. (1) There is created a commission to study the
7	effectiveness and efficiency of the Mississippi Adequate Education
8	Program (MAEP) in providing adequacy and equity in public school
9	funding. The commission shall, at a minimum, study and report on
10	the following factors related to MAEP:
11	(a) Efficiency;
12	(b) Selection of school districts for funding
13	calculations;
14	(c) High growth districts;
15	(d) State and local contributions; and
16	(e) Add on programs.
17	The State Board of Education shall contract with a consulting firm
18	that has expertise in public school funding formulas to assist the
19	commission with the study. The commission shall make a report of
20	its findings and recommendations to the Legislature by November 1,
21	2005, including any recommended legislation.
22	(2) The commission shall be composed of the following ten
23	(10) members:
24	(a) The Chairman of the House and Senate Education
25	Committees;
26	(b) The Chairman of the House and Senate Appropriation

28 (c) Three (3) representatives to be appointed by the29 Speaker of the House; and

30 (d) Three (3) senators to be appointed by the31 Lieutenant Governor.

32 (3) Appointments shall be made within thirty (30) days after
33 the effective date of this act. The commission shall hold its
34 first meeting before August 1, 2005. The Chairman of the House
35 Education Committee and the Chairman of the Senate Education
36 Committee shall serve as cochairmen of the commission.

37 (4) Members of the commission may not be compensated for the 38 performance of their duties. Any incidental costs associated with 39 conducting the study shall be paid by the State Department of 40 Education.

(5) To effectuate the purposes of this section, any department, division, board, bureau, commission or agency of the state or of any political subdivision thereof shall, at the request of the chairperson of the task force, provide to the commission such facilities, assistance and data as will enable the commission to properly carry out its duties.

47 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 48 and after its passage.
