HOUSE BILL NO. 1018

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 19-19-9, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
 ESTABLISH A PROCEDURE TO EXECUTE COURT ORDERS WHEN A CONSTABLE
 FAILS; TO AMEND SECTION 19-19-15, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
 REVISE THE PENALTY FOR NEGLECT OF DUTY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
 SECTION 1. Section 19-19-9, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
 amended as follows:

8 19-19-9. (1) If any constable or other officer fails to 9 execute and return, according to law, any execution to him 10 directed by any justice court judge, on or before the return day thereof, the plaintiff in execution may recover the amount 11 thereof, with interest and costs and five percent (5%) damages 12 thereon, by motion before the justice to whom the execution was 13 returnable, against the officer and his sureties. When any 14 constable, or such other officer, or his sureties, shall have paid 15 16 the amount of money and damages recovered, the original judgment 17 shall be vested in the person so paying. The justice, on motion, may fine the officer not exceeding Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for 18 19 failing to return such execution.

(2) In addition to the provisions of subsection (1) of this 20 section, if any constable receives an order from a court and fails 21 to execute and return such order within thirty (30) days, the 22 23 court upon motion of a party or upon its own motion may select 24 another constable to execute such order. The constable failing to execute such order shall be punished as provided by this section 25 26 or any other applicable section and shall explain such failure to 27 the court.

29 amended as follows:

30 19-19-15. A constable who shall fail to discharge any of the 31 duties required of him, when no other penalty is provided for such 32 failure, shall be liable to be fined, as for a contempt, not 33 exceeding <u>One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)</u> by the <u>justice court judge</u> 34 before whom the proceedings may be pending.

35 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 36 and after July 1, 2005.
