## HOUSE BILL NO. 1055

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 47-7-34, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT THE TOTAL NUMBER OF YEARS IMPOSED UNDER POST-RELEASE SUPERVISION SHALL NOT AFFECT THE MAXIMUM SENTENCE AUTHORIZED TO BE IMPOSED BY LAW FOR CERTAIN FELONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 47-7-34, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 47-7-34. (1) When a court imposes a sentence upon a
- 9 conviction for any felony committed after June 30, 1995, the
- 10 court, in addition to any other punishment imposed if the other
- 11 punishment includes a term of incarceration in a state or local
- 12 correctional facility, may impose a term of post-release
- 13 supervision. However, the total number of years \* \* \* of
- 14 post-release supervision shall not exceed the maximum sentence
- 15 authorized to be imposed by law for the felony committed. The
- 16 defendant shall be placed under post-release supervision upon
- 17 release from the term of incarceration. The period of supervision
- 18 shall be established by the court.
- 19 (2) The period of post-release supervision shall be
- 20 conducted in the same manner as a like period of supervised
- 21 probation, including a requirement that the defendant shall abide
- 22 by any terms and conditions as the court may establish. Failure
- $\,$  23  $\,$  to successfully abide by the terms and conditions shall be grounds
- 24 to terminate the period of post-release supervision and to
- 25 recommit the defendant to the correctional facility from which he
- 26 was previously released. Procedures for termination and
- 27 recommitment shall be conducted in the same manner as procedures

- 28 for the revocation of probation and imposition of a suspended
- 29 sentence.
- 30 (3) Post-release supervision programs shall be operated
- 31 through the probation and parole unit of the Division of Community
- 32 Corrections of the department. The maximum amount of time that
- 33 the Mississippi Department of Corrections may supervise an
- 34 offender on the post-release supervision program is five (5)
- 35 years.
- 36 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 37 and after July 1, 2005.
