- NAME THE MONUMENT THE "MISSISSIPPI FALLEN OFFICERS MONUMENT"; TO

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 9
- SECTION 1. Section 39-5-71, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 10
- 11 amended as follows:
- 39-5-71. (1) The Board on Law Enforcement Officer Standards 12
- and Training, in cooperation with the Department of Archives and 13
- 14 History and the Department of Finance and Administration, is * * *
- authorized, subject to funds being made available from legislative 15
- appropriation or the private sector, to cause to be constructed 16
- and maintained * * * a monument containing the names and paying 17
- tribute to all state, county and municipal law enforcement 18
- 19 officers, and all federal law enforcement officers employed and
- residing in Mississippi at the time of death, who have given their 20
- 21 lives in the performance of their official duties. The monument
- shall be known as the "Mississippi Fallen Officers Monument," and 22
- it shall be located on the grounds of the Capitol or on 23
- state-owned lands at a suitable and appropriate place in or near 24
- 25 the City of Jackson.
- It is the intent of the Legislature that adequate space be 26
- left on the monument to be available to add names of law 27
- 28 enforcement officers in the future who give their lives in the
- performance of their official duties. 29

30	(2) The Board on Law Enforcement Officer Standards and
31	Training is * * * authorized to accept gifts, grants and donations
32	from individuals and organizations, to be deposited in the Law
33	Enforcement Officers Monument Fund which is hereby created as a
34	special fund in the State Treasury. The State Treasurer shall
35	invest all monies in the fund and any interest earned shall be
36	deposited into the fund. All funds deposited in the fund,
37	including interest earned thereon, shall be used for the purpose
38	of fund-raising, erecting and maintaining the monument as provided
39	in subsection (1) of this section. The funds may be used for any
40	fund-raising activity the board deems necessary for the
41	construction and maintenance of the monument. Any monies
42	remaining unexpended or unencumbered in the fund upon completion
43	of the monument shall revert to the Board on Law Enforcement
44	Officer Standards and Training for maintenance of the monument.
45	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

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and after July 1, 2005.
