- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-7-21, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 INCREASE CHANCERY CLERK FEES FOR COLLECTION OF DELINQUENT TAXES; 2 3 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4
- SECTION 1. Section 25-7-21, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5
- amended as follows: 6
- 7 25-7-21. (1) From and after October 1, 1985, there will be
- 8 no fees for the services of the tax collector, with the exception
- of taxes collected for taxing authorities other than the board of 9
- supervisors. For collecting taxes for authorities other than the 10
- board of supervisors, the fee shall be five percent (5%) of the 11
- 12 taxes collected or an amount authorized by contract between the
- 13 county and the outside taxing authority. A tax collector shall
- keep a complete account of every such fee collected and shall file 14
- 15 an itemized statement thereof monthly, under oath, with the clerk
- of the board of supervisors of the county who shall preserve same 16
- as a part of the records of the office. The tax collector shall 17
- 18 make a remittance to the clerk of the board of supervisors of the
- county on or before the twentieth of each month for deposit into 19
- 20 the general fund of the county of all said fees collected during
- 21 the preceding month.
- (2) For the purpose of the limitations set forth in Section 22
- 27-39-321, commissions for levies set by the board of supervisors 23
- shall be added to base collections of the general county fund for 24

46	The several officers' fees shall be collected by the tax
47	collector or chancery clerk and paid over to those entitled to

49	SECTION 2. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi
50	shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor,
51	or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the
52	Attorney General of the United States or to the United States
53	District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the
54	provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and
55	extended.
56	SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
57	and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting
58	Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.
