HOUSE BILL NO. 1166

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT A FULL-TIME FIRE FIGHTER MAY RETAIN
2 HIS HELMET AND BADGE WHEN HE RETIRES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** Each full-time fire fighter, employed in
5 accordance with Section 45-11-203, who retires under Section
6 21-29-139 or the Public Employees' Retirement System, for
7 superannuation or for reason of disability, or any other local
8 government retirement system shall be allowed to retain, as his
9 personal property, one (1) helmet and one (1) badge which were
10 issued to him by the local government fire fighting unit.

11 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
12 and after July 1, 2005.
