HOUSE BILL NO. 1190

AN ACT TO ABOLISH THE MISSISSIPPI VETERANS MEMORIAL STADIUM 2 COMMISSION AND TRANSFER ITS DUTIES TO THE JACKSON STATE UNIVERSITY 3 STADIUM COMMISSION, WHICH SHALL BE ESTABLISHED BY JACKSON STATE UNIVERSITY; TO PROVIDE THAT THE STADIUM SHALL BE UNDER THE 4 EXCLUSIVE JURISDICTION OF THE JACKSON STATE UNIVERSITY STADIUM 5 COMMISSION; TO AMEND SECTION 55-23-5, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 6 7 CONFORM TO THE PRECEDING PROVISIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 9 SECTION 1. (1) The Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium 10 Commission is abolished on July 1, 2005, and all records, duties, responsibilities, assets, contractual rights and obligations, 11 property rights and any unexpended balances of appropriations that 12 are vested on June 30, 2005, in the Mississippi Veterans Memorial 13 Stadium Commission, are vested on July 1, 2005, in the Jackson 14 15 State University Stadium Commission established under subsection (2) of this section. From and after July 1, 2005, the Mississippi 16 17 Veterans Memorial Stadium shall be under the exclusive jurisdiction of the Jackson State University Stadium Commission, 18 and the Jackson State University Stadium Commission shall assume 19 20 all liabilities and indebtedness of the stadium. The Jackson State University Stadium Commission is authorized to enter into 21 any contractual agreement for the purpose of leasing the stadium 22 23 to provide revenue to help retire any indebtedness of the stadium. 24 However, the Legislature, in its discretion, may retire all 25 obligations on the stadium by making an appropriation for that purpose from the State General Fund. In no event shall the 26 appropriation for the upkeep of the stadium be less than the 27 28 fiscal year 2005 appropriation made to the Mississippi Veterans 29 Memorial Stadium Commission for its operation.
