- 6 **SECTION 1.** (1) Any home health care worker who witnesses a
- 7 criminal offense is authorized to report such criminal offense to
- 8 the appropriate law enforcement agency. A home health care worker
- 9 shall not be liable in any civil action for making a report under
- 10 this section, if such home health care worker had a good faith
- 11 reasonable belief that a criminal offense was committed.
- 12 (2) For the purposes of this section, "home health care
- 13 worker" means any person licensed or employed to provide medical
- 14 or health services in the private residence of a patient, whether
- 15 such person is employed by the state or any of its political
- 16 subdivisions or by a private health care provider.
