HOUSE BILL NO. 1211

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE OWNER OF AN ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE TO REGISTER SUCH VEHICLE WITH THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT OF THE COUNTY 3 OF HIS OR HER RESIDENCE; TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC 4 SAFETY TO ESTABLISH A STATEWIDE ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE REGISTRATION NETWORK DESIGNED TO PROVIDE IMMEDIATE RESPONSE TO SHERIFFS' 5 6 DEPARTMENTS AND LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES WITH REGARD TO REPORTS OR 7 COMPLAINTS OF STOLEN OR MISSING ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES; TO PROVIDE FOR THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSITION OF FEES FOR OPERATION AND 8 MAINTENANCE OF THE NETWORK; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 9

- 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 11 SECTION 1. (1) The term "all-terrain vehicle" or "ATV," as
- 12 used in this section, means any motorized vehicle manufactured and
- 13 designed exclusively for off-road use that is fifty (50) inches or
- 14 less in width, has an unladen dry weight of six hundred (600)
- 15 pounds or less, travels on three (3), four (4) or more low
- 16 pressure tires, has a seat designed to be straddled by the
- 17 operator and uses handlebars for steering control.
- 18 (2) Beginning July 1, 2005, every owner of an all-terrain
- 19 vehicle who is a resident of this state, shall register such
- 20 vehicle with the sheriff of the county in which the owner resides.
- 21 Registration shall be made in duplicate on a form prepared and
- 22 provided to the sheriff by the Mississippi Department of Public
- 23 Safety. Each form shall include (a) the name and address of the
- 24 owner of the vehicle; (b) the age and sex of the owner; (c) the
- 25 make, model and serial number of the vehicle; (d) the name and
- 26 address of the person, firm or business from whom such vehicle was
- 27 acquired or purchased and the date of acquisition or purchase; and
- 28 (e) the place where such vehicle is usually kept.
- 29 (3) The original registration form shall be retained by the
- 30 sheriff in a safe and convenient file to be furnished him by the

- 31 board of supervisors for that purpose and also may be recorded on 32 computer or other electronic format. All registrations shall be 33 filed and arranged and/or formatted for retrieval in alphabetical order and shall be open to public inspection as required under the 34 35 Mississippi Public Records Act of 1983. A copy of the 36 registration form shall be forwarded to the Department of Public 37 Safety within thirty (30) days after completion of registration. The department shall file and maintain copies of all registrations 38 filed with it and shall establish and maintain a statewide ATV 39 40 registration network designed to provide immediate response to sheriffs' departments and other law enforcement agencies with 41 regard to reports or complaints of stolen or missing ATVs. At the 42 time of registration, the sheriff shall issue to the registrant a 43 decal for placement on the ATV. The decal shall be designed by 44 the Department of Public Safety and shall be provided to the 45 sheriff by the department. Each decal shall contain such numbers 46 47 and/or other vehicle identifying information as the Department of Public Safety may prescribe. 48 (4) At the time of registration, the registrant shall pay to 49 50
- the sheriff a one-time fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00). Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the fee shall be forwarded to the Department of Public 51 52 Safety at the time that the sheriff's department is required under subsection (3) of this section to provide the department with a 53 54 copy of the registration. Two Dollars (\$2.00) of the fee shall be 55 retained by the sheriff and shall be paid to the chancery clerk for deposit into the general fund of the county. 56 57 received by the Department of Public Safety shall be expended by 58 the department, upon appropriation by the Legislature, for the 59 expenses the department incurs in complying with the provisions of 60 this section.
- 61 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 62 and after July 1, 2005.
