## HOUSE BILL NO. 1214

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 19-5-18, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 PROVIDE THAT THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MAY AUTHORIZE THE TAX 3 COLLECTOR/ASSESSOR TO INCLUDE GARBAGE COLLECTION FEES ON THE 4 ADVALOREM TAX BILL; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 19-5-18, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:

8 19-5-18. (1) To defray the cost of establishing, operating 9 and maintaining the system provided for in Section 19-5-17, the 10 board of supervisors may develop a system for the billing and/or the collection of any fees or charges imposed on each person 11 furnished garbage and/or rubbish collection and/or disposal 12 service by the county or at the expense of the county. The board 13 of supervisors may designate, by resolution, a county official to 14 collect the fees or charges. If the board of supervisors 15 16 designates an elected county official to collect the fees or charges, the board of supervisors shall pay the reasonable costs 17 incurred in collecting the fees or charges. The county official 18 19 so designated shall notify the board of supervisors monthly of any unpaid fees or charges assessed under Section 19-5-21. 20 The sheriff of the county, in accordance with the performance of his 21 regular duties, shall assist in the collection of any delinquent 22 23 fees or charges.

The board of supervisors may enter into a contract upon 24 (2)25 mutual agreement with a public or private corporation, nonprofit 26 corporation, planning and development district or a public agency, association, utility or utility district within the county and/or 27 28 the area receiving garbage and/or rubbish collection and/or \*HR40/R1778\* H. disposal services from the county for the purpose of developing, 29 30 maintaining, operating and administering a system for the billing and/or collection of fees or charges imposed by the county for 31 32 garbage and/or rubbish collection and/or disposal services. The 33 entity with whom the board of supervisors contracts shall notify the board of supervisors monthly of any unpaid fees or charges 34 assessed under Section 19-5-21. Any entity that contracts to 35 provide a service to customers, within the area being served by 36 the county's garbage and/or rubbish collection and/or disposal 37 system, may provide a list of its customers to the board of 38 39 supervisors upon the request of the board.

40 (3) The board of supervisors may authorize the tax
41 <u>collector/assessor to include the fees or charges for garbage or</u>
42 <u>rubbish collection or disposal service on the annual advalorem tax</u>
43 <u>bill.</u>

44 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 45 and after July 1, 2005.
