## HOUSE BILL NO. 1281

- AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO ISSUE
  PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION CARDS FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES; TO
  PRESCRIBE THE INFORMATION TO BE INCLUDED ON THE IDENTIFICATION
  CARD; TO PROVIDE FOR RENEWAL OF THE IDENTIFICATION CARD; TO
  PROVIDE FOR A FEE FOR ISSUANCE OF THE CARD; TO PROVIDE THAT MISUSE
  OF THE IDENTIFICATION CARDS FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES SHALL BE
  A MISDEMEANOR; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 9 **SECTION 1.** As used in this article, the term:
- 10 (a) "Commissioner" means the Commissioner of the
  11 Department of Public Safety.
- 12 (b) "Department" means Department of Public Safety.
- 13 (c) "Disability" means any physical, mental or
- 14 neurological impairment which severely restricts a person's
- 15 mobility, manual dexterity or ability to climb stairs; substantial
- 16 loss of sight or hearing; loss of one or more limbs or use
- 17 thereof; or significantly diminished reasoning capacity.
- 18 (d) "Identification card for persons with disabilities"
- 19 means an identification card issued as provided in this act.
- 20 (e) "Permanent disability" means any disability which
- 21 is permanent in nature or which is expected to continue for a
- 22 period of at least five (5) years.
- 23 (f) "Person with disabilities" means any person with a
- 24 permanent or temporary disability.
- 25 (g) "Temporary disability" means any disability which
- 26 is expected to continue for at least six (6) months but less than
- 27 five (5) years.
- 28 SECTION 2. (1) The Department of Public Safety shall issue
- 29 personal identification cards to persons with disabilities who

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make application to the department in accordance with rules and
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    regulations prescribed by the commissioner. The identification
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    card for persons with disabilities shall prominently display the
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    international handicapped symbol and, in addition to any other
    information required by this act, may contain a recent color
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    photograph of the applicant and the following information:

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         (2) The identification card for persons with disabilities
    shall bear the signatures of the commissioner and the Governor and
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    shall bear an identification card number which shall not be the
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    same as the applicant's social security number, unless the person
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    specifically requests that the social security number be used, or,
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    in the case of an individual who is not a citizen of the United
    States, the passport number of the person identified or any number
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    the department deems necessary to implement this act.
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         SECTION 3. (1) The identification card for persons with
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    disabilities shall be issued to a person with a permanent
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    disability for a period of four (4) years and shall be renewable
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on the applicant's birthday in the fourth year following such

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- 63 issuance. The identification cards shall be issued to persons:
- 64 (a) With obvious permanent disabilities without further
- 65 verification of disability; and
- (b) With disabilities which are not obvious upon
- 67 presentation of the current sworn affidavit of at least one (1)
- 68 medical doctor attesting to such permanent disability. A current
- 69 affidavit shall be presented at each request for renewal.
- 70 (2) The identification card for persons with disabilities
- 71 shall be issued to a person with a temporary disability upon
- 72 presentation of a sworn affidavit of at least one (1) medical
- 73 doctor attesting to such disability and estimating the duration of
- 74 such disability. Such identification cards shall be issued for
- 75 periods of six (6) months. A current affidavit of a medical
- 76 doctor attesting to the continuance of such disability shall be
- 77 presented at each request for renewal thereafter.
- 78 **SECTION 4.** The face of the identification card for persons
- 79 with disabilities shall prominently bear the words "URGENT MEDICAL
- 80 INFORMATION ON REVERSE." On the reverse side of the
- 81 identification card shall be a space within which the issuer of
- 82 the card shall enter such medical information as the applicant may
- 83 request.
- 84 **SECTION 5.** The face of the identification card for persons
- 85 with disabilities shall bear the word "TRANSPORTATION" with a box
- 86 or blank space adjacent thereto. The issuer of the card shall
- 87 place an 'X' in such box or blank space if the applicant's
- 88 disability creates mobility limitations which prevent him or her
- 89 from climbing stairs or otherwise from entering normally designed
- 90 buses or other vehicles normally used for public transportation.
- 91 When so marked, the identification card for persons with
- 92 disabilities shall serve as sufficient proof of the need for
- 93 special transportation services for persons with disabilities
- 94 provided by any entity in this state.

- 95 SECTION 6. The identification card for persons with disabilities shall bear the word "SEATING" with a box or blank 96 space adjacent thereto. The issuer of the card shall place an "X" 97 98 in such box or blank space if the applicant's disability creates 99 mobility or health limitations which prevent him or her from 100 climbing stairs or steep inclines. When so marked, the 101 identification card for persons with disabilities shall be 102 sufficient to admit the holder to seating for persons with 103 disabilities at public events in this state.
- 104 <u>SECTION 7.</u> The commissioner shall promulgate rules and 105 regulations under which this article shall be implemented.
- 106 <u>SECTION 8.</u> The department shall require an applicant for an identification card for persons with disabilities to furnish a birth certificate or other verifiable evidence stating the applicant's birth date.
- 110 <u>SECTION 9.</u> The department shall collect a fee of Five
  111 Dollars (\$5.00) for an identification card for persons with
  112 disabilities, which fee shall be deposited in the State Treasury
  113 in the same manner as motor vehicle driver's license fees.
- 114 **SECTION 10.** It is a misdemeanor for any person:
- 115 (1) To lend his or her identification card for persons with 116 disabilities to any other person or knowingly to permit the use 117 thereof by another; and
- 118 (2) To display or represent as his or her own any
  119 identification card for persons with disabilities not issued to
  120 him or her.
- 121 **SECTION 11.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 122 and after July 1, 2005.
