AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 83-41-211, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
 TO PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN INSURANCE POLICIES SHALL PROVIDE
 REIMBURSEMENT FOR SERVICES RENDERED BY MARRIAGE AND FAMILY
 THERAPISTS FOR THE TREATMENT OF MENTAL, NERVOUS OR EMOTIONAL
 DISORDERS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

7 SECTION 1. Section 83-41-211, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

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## [Until July 1, 2008, this section shall read as follows:]

83-41-211. Whenever any policy of insurance or any medical 10 service plan or hospital service contract or hospital and medical 11 service contract issued in this state provides for reimbursement 12 for any diagnosis and treatment of mental, nervous or emotional 13 14 disorders only which are within the lawful scope of practice of a duly licensed psychologist as defined in Section 73-31-3, within 15 16 the lawful scope of practice of a duly licensed professional counselor as defined in Section 73-30-3, \* \* \* within the lawful 17 scope of practice of a duly licensed clinical social worker as 18 19 defined in Section 73-53-3, or within the lawful scope of practice of a duly licensed marriage and family therapist as defined in 20 Section 73-54-5, the insured or other person entitled to benefits 21 22 under such policy shall be entitled to reimbursement for such services, whether such services are performed by a duly licensed 23 24 physician or by a duly licensed psychologist, by a duly licensed professional counselor, by a duly licensed clinical social worker 25 or by a duly licensed marriage and family therapist, 26 27 notwithstanding any provision to the contrary in any statute or in

A duly licensed professional counselor shall be entitled to participate 32 33 in such policies, plans or contracts providing for the diagnosis 34 and treatment of mental, nervous or emotional disorders only as authorized by Section 73-30-3. A duly licensed clinical social 35 36 worker shall be entitled to participate in such policies, plans or contracts providing for the diagnosis and treatment of mental, 37 38 nervous or emotional disorders only as authorized by Section 39 A duly licensed marriage and family therapist shall be 73-53-3. 40 entitled to participate in such policies, plans or contracts providing for the diagnosis and treatment of mental, nervous or 41 42 emotional disorders only as authorized by Section 73-54-5 et seq. The addition of marriage and family therapists as providers 43 44 herein is intended to only allow them to treat mental, nervous or 45 emotional disorders as treated by other providers, to the extent 46 that marriage and family therapists are qualified to treat such 47 disorders. Notwithstanding anything in this section to the contrary, the scope or definition of mental, nervous or emotional 48 49 disorders shall remain the same and shall not be expanded by the 50 addition of marriage and family therapists as allowable providers.

defined in Section 73-53-3, the insured or other person entitled 62 63 to benefits under such policy shall be entitled to reimbursement 64 for such services, whether such services are performed by a duly licensed physician or by a duly licensed psychologist, by a duly 65 66 licensed professional counselor, by a duly licensed clinical 67 social worker, notwithstanding any provision to the contrary in 68 any statute or in such policy, plan or contract. Duly licensed psychologists shall be entitled to participate in such policies, 69 plans or contracts providing for the diagnosis and treatment of 70 71 mental, nervous or emotional disorders only as authorized by 72 Section 73-31-3. A duly licensed professional counselor shall be entitled to participate in such policies, plans or contracts 73 74 providing for the diagnosis and treatment of mental, nervous or emotional disorders only as authorized by Section 73-30-3. A duly 75 76 licensed clinical social worker shall be entitled to participate in such policies, plans or contracts providing for the diagnosis 77 78 and treatment of mental, nervous or emotional disorders only as 79 authorized by Section 73-53-3.

80 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 81 and after July 1, 2005.
