- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 73-13-35, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 73-13-35. The board may, upon application therefor and the
- 9 payment of a fee in accordance with Section 73-13-25, issue a
- 10 certificate of licensure as a professional engineer to any person
- 11 who holds a certificate of qualification or licensure issued to
- 12 him by proper authority of any state or territory or possession of
- 13 the United States, or of any country, provided that the
- 14 applicant's qualifications meet the requirements of Sections
- 15 73-13-1 through 73-13-45 and the rules established by the board
- 16 and any licensed professional engineer in good standing and
- 17 currently engaged in the practice of engineering with at least
- 18 twenty-five (25) years of experience and a masters degree in the
- 19 field of engineering from a school or college approved by the
- 20 board as of satisfactory standing in another state shall be
- 21 qualified for licensure as a professional engineer without
- 22 examination.
- 23 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 24 and after July 1, 2005.
