- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4
- SECTION 1. Section 49-7-33, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5
- amended as follows: 6
- 7 (1) It is unlawful to hunt, trap or kill any wild
- 8 bird or wild animal of any kind with the aid of bait, recordings
- of bird or animal calls, or electrically amplified imitations of 9
- calls of any kind, except a person: 10
- (a) May use electrically amplified sound devices for 11
- 12 hunting coyote and crow;
- 13 (b) May use liquid scents for any animal or bird; and
- (c) May use lures for trapping furbearing animals, 14
- beaver, coyote, fox and nutria according to regulations adopted by 15
- the commission. 16
- The commission, in its discretion, may relax the 17 (2)
- 18 restrictions regarding the use of lures or sound devices if a
- condition arises or exists, as decided by the State Board of 19
- 20 Health or county board of health, that may endanger persons or
- 21 livestock in a certain community, county or area.

- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 23
- and after July 1, 2005. 24
