Section 27-7-91, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 8 27-7-91. (1) Each resident individual taxpayer who files a 9 Mississippi income tax return and who will receive a tax refund 10 from the State Tax Commission may designate that a contribution be 11 made to the "Mississippi Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks Foundation" 12 13 by marking the appropriate box printed on the return pursuant to 14 this subsection. In the case of a joint return, each spouse may designate that a portion of the refund shall be paid to such fund. 15 16 The State Tax Commission shall print on the Mississippi 17 income tax form for residents a space for designating the contribution in substantially the following form: 18 19 "MISSISSIPPI WILDLIFE FISHERIES AND PARKS FOUNDATION * * * I wish to contribute ()\$1 ()\$5 ()\$10 () other 20 21 _____ of my TAX REFUND TO THE Ś 22 MISSISSIPPI WILDLIFE, FISHERIES AND PARKS FOUNDATION." 23 (2) The State Tax Commission shall explain in the instructions accompanying the individual income tax form the 24 purposes for which the contributions authorized herein shall be 25 used. 26

(3) This section shall apply to taxable years beginning on
or after January 1, <u>2005</u>.

29 SECTION 2. Section 27-7-93, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 30 amended as follows:

31 27-7-93. (1) The Chairman of the State Tax Commission shall 32 determine annually the total amount designated by individuals to 33 be paid to the fund, along with all interest earned thereon, and 34 shall report such amount to the State Treasurer who shall pay such 35 amount into the <u>Mississippi Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks</u> 36 Foundation.

The Mississippi Commission on Wildlife, Fisheries and 37 (2)Parks may expend such monies deposited into the foundation 38 39 pursuant to subsection (1) of this section only to implement the "Mississippi Natural Heritage Law of 1978," Sections 49-5-141 40 through 49-5-157, Mississippi Code of 1972, by providing for the 41 protection and management of nongame species, threatened or 42 endangered wildlife or plants, and unique geological formations 43 such as waterfalls, caves and canyons, and by purchasing, leasing, 44 registering, dedicating and maintaining natural areas. 45 46 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from

47 and after its passage.
