## HOUSE BILL NO. 1420

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-41, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO EXEMPT HUNTERS FIFTEEN YEARS OF AGE AND YOUNGER FROM THE REQUIREMENT THAT AN ANTLERED DEER MUST HAVE AT LEAST FOUR POINTS TO BE TAKEN; TO AUTHORIZE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SPECIFIC MANAGEMENT BUCK CRITERIA FOR ANTLERED DEER TAKEN BY PERMIT ON LANDS UNDER THE DEER MANAGEMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM OR WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREAS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 9 SECTION 1. Section 49-7-41, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 10 amended as follows:

11 49-7-41. (1) The commission may set the bag limits for game 12 animals, birds and fish, unless the bag limits are established by 13 the Legislature by statute.

(2) (a) The bag limit on antlered deer is one (1) per day, 14 not to exceed three (3) per license year. Except for hunters 15 fifteen (15) years of age and younger and except as otherwise 16 17 provided in paragraph (b) of this subsection, an antlered deer must have antlers of four (4) points or greater to be taken \* \* \*. 18 (b) An antlered deer with less than four (4) points, or 19 20 antlered deer that meet specific management buck criteria, may be taken by permit whenever it is necessary to manage deer on lands 21 22 under the deer management assistance program or wildlife 23 management areas. A written management justification issued by 24 the Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks must accompany any request for such a permit. Any antlered deer \* \* \* harvested 25 under this permit must be identified with a tag immediately upon 26 possession. Antlered deer taken by permit shall not be subject to 27 28 the daily bag limit or the annual bag limit on antlered deer. The 29 department shall include a report on permits issued, to whom

30 issued and deer harvested in the department's annual deer program 31 report.

32 (3) (a) The bag limit on antlerless deer is one (1)
33 per day, not to exceed three (3) per license year; except that two
34 (2) additional antlerless deer per license year may be taken with
35 a bow and arrow. Antlerless deer may be taken only in the areas
36 prescribed by order of the commission. It is illegal to take a
37 spotted fawn in any season.

(b) It is unlawful for a nonresident to kill an 38 antlerless deer except: (i) a nonresident may take antlerless 39 40 deer on lands that the title is vested in the nonresident or on lands that the nonresident has leased the hunting and fishing 41 42 rights; or (ii) a nonresident who has a native son or daughter nonresident lifetime sportsman license or a resident lifetime 43 44 sportsman license may take antlerless deer on private lands, wildlife management areas or national wildlife refuges. 45

46 (4) The bag limit on antlerless deer set by this section
47 shall not apply to private lands under the deer management
48 assistance program or the fee-based antlerless program as approved
49 by the department.
