## HOUSE BILL NO. 1487

1	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-25-506, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
2	TO PROVIDE THAT ALL OF THE STATE'S SHARE OF OIL AND GAS SEVERANCE
3	TAXES SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE STATE GENERAL FUND; AND FOR
4	RELATED PURPOSES.

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 27-25-506, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 27-25-506. There is created a special fund in the State
- 9 Treasury into which the state's share of proceeds collected under
- 10 Sections 27-25-505 and 27-25-705 shall be deposited.
- 11 The state's share of all oil and gas severance taxes derived
- 12 from oil and gas resources under state-owned lands or from severed
- 13 state-owned minerals shall be deposited into the State Treasury to
- 14 the credit of the trust fund created in Section 206A, Mississippi
- 15 Constitution of 1890. The following amounts of the remainder of
- 16 tax collections apportioned to the state shall be deposited to the
- 17 credit of the trust fund created in Section 206A, Mississippi
- 18 Constitution of 1890:
- 19 (a) For fiscal year 1994, all amounts collected in
- 20 excess of Thirty-five Million Dollars (\$35,000,000.00);
- 21 (b) For fiscal year 1995, all amounts collected in
- 22 excess of Thirty-two Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars
- 23 (\$32,500,000.00);
- 24 (c) For fiscal year 1996, all amounts collected in
- excess of Thirty Million Dollars (\$30,000,000.00);
- 26 (d) For fiscal year 1997, all amounts collected in
- 27 excess of Twenty-seven Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars
- 28 (\$27,500,000.00);
