HOUSE BILL NO. 1550

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 77-15-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
PROHIBIT MEMBERS OF THE BOARDS OF DIRECTORS OF NATURAL GAS
DISTRICTS FROM RECEIVING ANY COMPENSATION OTHER THAN PER DIEM AND
ACTUAL TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 77-15-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:

8 77-15-1. Notwithstanding any other provisions of law to the 9 contrary, all local natural gas districts containing two (2) or 10 more municipalities and nonmunicipal customers shall establish and maintain a board of directors composed of: (a) the mayors of each 11 municipality within the district whose terms shall be concurrent 12 with their terms of office as mayor; and (b) one (1) system-user 13 from each county within the district, who shall not be a public 14 official. The county system-user board members shall be elected 15 16 by the system-users residing outside of a municipality, in the county in which such board member resides. In order to qualify as 17 a candidate for election to the board, each person shall obtain, 18 19 on a petition, twenty-five (25) signatures from system-users in the county in which such person resides. The signatures shall be 20 21 of system-users residing outside of a municipality and the candidate shall be a system-user who resides outside of a 22 23 municipality. The board shall call an election within fifteen (15) days after July 1, 1989, to be held within sixty (60) days 24 from the date such election is called. Those persons elected to 25 26 the board shall serve until the next general election for supervisors and the election for such board members thereafter 27 shall be held at the same time as the supervisor elections and the 28 *HR40/R1691* H. terms of such board members shall be concurrent with the terms of 29 30 the supervisors. Any mayor who devotes a substantial amount of 31 time to the operations of a local natural gas district may receive 32 additional compensation as approved by the board of directors. 33 From and after July 1, 2005, directors of natural gas districts who are operating in conformity to this section may receive 34 compensation in the amount of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per day for 35 actual service rendered to the district and actual travel 36 expenses. No such director shall receive any salary or other form 37 of compensation except for what is provided in this section. 38 39 All board members shall file any required statements of

40 economic interest with the Ethics Commission as required by law.
41 This section shall not apply to any local natural gas district
42 which leases its distribution system to an investor-owned utility
43 company regulated by the Public Service Commission.

From and after July 1, 2004, the Board of Directors of the Chickasawhay Natural Gas District shall discontinue distribution of any of the revenues of the district to municipalities within the district.

48 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 49 and after July 1, 2005.
