HOUSE BILL NO. 1612

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE 1 STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE 2 3 MISSISSIPPI STATE BOARD OF PHYSICAL THERAPY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 4 2006. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 7 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 8 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of Physical 9 Therapy, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the 10 Mississippi State Board of Physical Therapy for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... 11 12\$ 123,463.00. SECTION 2. 33 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 34 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 35 Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006 36 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 37 38 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the 39 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 40 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 41 42 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 43 act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 44 45 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 46 47 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 48 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 49 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 50 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 51 52 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 53 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 54 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

55 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 56 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 57 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 58 59 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 60 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 61 *HR05/A837* H. B. 62 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 63 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 68 Mississippi State Board of Physical Therapy shall maintain 69 complete accounting and personnel records related to the 70 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such 71 72 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2005. It is further the intention of 73 74 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee 75 76 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request 77 78 process.

79 SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 80 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 81 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 82 83 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 84 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from 85 86 and after July 1, 2005.

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
