33	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to			
34	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal			
35	Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006			
36	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions			
37	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the			
38	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the

None of the funds herein appropriated by this act to the Public Service Commission shall be expended for any purpose that is not actually required or necessary for performing any of the powers or duties of the Mississippi Public Service Commission that are authorized by the Mississippi Constitution of 1890, state or federal law, or rules or regulations that implement state or federal law.

74 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 75 Public Service Commission shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 76 77 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 78 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 79 80 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 81 82 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process. 83

84 **SECTION 5.** In addition to all other sums herein 85 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 86 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury 87 to the credit of the Public Service Commission, for the purpose of 88 defraying the expenses of the Public Service Commission to administer the Mississippi Telephone Solicitation Act, for the 89 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... 90 91 .....\$ 160,000.00.
