1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI AUTHORITY FOR EDUCATIONAL TELEVISION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2006.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Authority for
9	Educational Television for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005,
LO	and ending June 30, 2006\$ 5,053,048.00.
L1	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
L2	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
L3	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi
L4	Authority for Educational Television which is comprised of special
L5	source funds collected by or otherwise available to the Authority,
L6	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Authority for the
L7	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006
L8	\$ 4,781,431.00.
L9	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
20	Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below
21	shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
22	expenditure:

43	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of				
44	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to				
45	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal				
46	Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006				
47	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions				
48	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the				
49	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the				
50	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall				
51	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all				
52	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this				
53	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure				
54	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual				
55	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal				
56	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.				
57	If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal				
58	Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency				
59	has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this				
60 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Se					
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61 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which

- 62 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 63 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 64 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 66 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 67 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 68 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 69 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 70 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 71 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 72 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 73 appropriated level.
- 74 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 75 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 76 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 77 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 78 Funds appropriated herein shall first be used for the
- 79 continuation of a full and complete broadcast schedule of
- 80 educational and instructional, professional growth, and public
- 81 service programs, with the production of new films and programs to
- 82 be secondary thereto.
- 83 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 84 Mississippi Authority for Educational Television shall maintain
- 85 complete accounting and personnel records related to the
- 86 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such
- 87 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as
- 88 maintained for Fiscal Year 2005. It is further the intention of
- 89 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year
- 90 2007 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee
- 91 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level
- 92 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request
- 93 process.

- 94 **SECTION 5.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- 95 Section 2, One Million Six Hundred Forty-four Thousand Sixty-seven
- 96 Dollars (\$1,644,067.00) shall be derived from the Education
- 97 Enhancement Fund deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and
- 98 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 99 **SECTION 6.** No part of the funds appropriated herein shall be
- 100 transferred to, expended by, or used, directly or indirectly, for
- 101 the benefit of any public relations, publicity or publication
- 102 activities of any other state agency, department or officer, nor
- 103 shall any personnel paid or equipment purchased with funds
- 104 appropriated hereby be transferred or assigned to any other state
- 105 agency, department or officer for public relations, publicity or
- 106 publication activities of such office.
- 107 **SECTION 7.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 108 Mississippi Authority for Educational Television shall have the
- 109 authority to expend funds in the Capital Equipment Replacement
- 110 Revolving Fund, in accordance with Section 37-63-17, Mississippi
- 111 Code of 1972, Annotated, for the purpose of purchasing technical
- 112 equipment for operating the educational radio and television
- 113 facilities.
- 114 SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 115 Mississippi Authority for Educational Television shall have the
- 116 authority to escalate its budget and expend funds from any source
- 117 not to exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) in accordance
- 118 with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and
- 119 Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of
- 120 federal funds.
- 121 **SECTION 9.** In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance
- 122 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of
- 123 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized
- 124 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the
- 125 intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized,
